NORTHSIDE

CIVIL RIGHTS DISTRICT

Experience one of the most significant chapters in American history in the Civil Rights District.

Visit the Birmingham Civil Rights Institute, 16th Street Baptist Church, Kelly Ingram Park, and the historic A.G. Gaston Motel while exploring the stories that helped shape a movement.

HISTORIC CITY CENTER

The heart of Downtown Birmingham, the Historic City Center blends iconic architecture, vibrant streetscapes, and some of the city's most recognizable landmarks.

Explore the Alabama Theatre, Birmingham Museum of Art, and Morris Avenue, then enjoy local dining and shopping at The Pizitz Food Hall and along 20th Street North.

THE SWITCH

Once defined by railroad tracks crisscrossing the historic 14th Street Switchyard, The Switch is where innovation meets creativity. The Switch is Birmingham's emerging hub for entrepreneurs, startups, and forward-thinking businesses. Anchored by Innovation Depot, this district showcases the city's growing technology and creative industries.

UPTOWN

Birmingham's premier entertainment district is home to the city's biggest events, concerts, and sporting experiences.

Catch a game or show at Protective Stadium, Legacy Arena, or the Birmingham-Jefferson Convention Complex, then enjoy dining and gathering spaces throughout the district.

FIVE POINTS SOUTH

One of Birmingham's most iconic neighborhoods, Five Points South blends historic charm with award-winning restaurants, nightlife, and local culture.

From casual hangs to signature events and culinary destinations like Chez Fonfon, this district embodies the city's creative spirit.

SOUTHSIDE

LAKEVIEW

Eclectic, energetic, and full of character, Lakeview is known for its mix of restaurants, breweries, galleries, and unique local businesses.

Explore Pepper Place, visit the historic Sloss Furnaces, try the burger at Back Forty Brewing Co., and enjoy one of Birmingham's most dynamic dining and nightlife scenes.

PARKSIDE

Centered around Railroad Park and Regions Field, Parkside offers one of Downtown Birmingham's most active and scenic experiences in a district that feels residential, welcoming and community oriented.

Enjoy green space at Railroad Park, Birmingham Barons baseball, local craft beer at Good People Brewing Co., live performances at Red Mountain, and family-friendly attractions all within walking distance.

SOUTHSIDE

Southside combines everyday convenience with local flavor and entertainment. Home to UAB medical facilities, neighborhood dining, breweries, and the Rotary Trail, it's a vibrant district where residents, students, and visitors intersect.

Visit The Painted Lady Hotel and enjoy a drink at Bygones or Birmingham District Brewing Co.

UAB CAMPUS

Driven by education, research, and innovation, the UAB Campus district brings youthful energy to Downtown Birmingham.

Explore the UAB Green, attend a performance at the Alys Robinson Stephens Performing Arts Center, or experience contemporary art at the Abroms-Engel Institute for the Visual Arts.

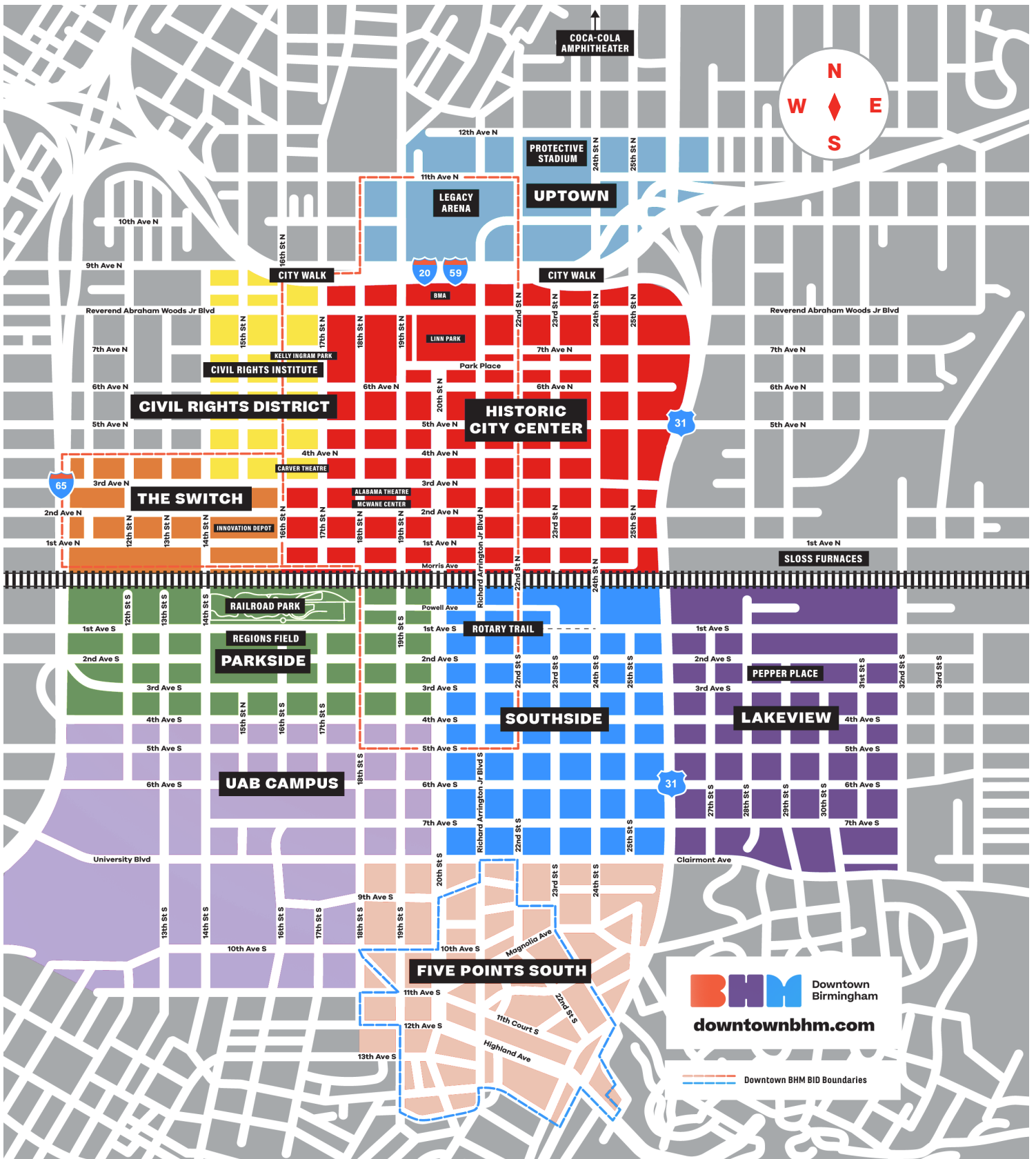
